## Presentation Format

We invite you to submit abstracts for oral or poster presentations. You can indicate your preferred presentation format (details below) in the registration form. The abstract is limited to a maximum of 300 words.

Three prizes, each including a book plus 50 Euros price money, will be awarded to the best oral and poster presentations. The prizes are sponsored by ThermoFisher.

## Oral Presentations

Oral presentations are 15 minutes plus 2 minutes for questions. A maximum of 30 presentations can be scheduled on the two days. Therefore, we might not be able to accommodate everyone and may advise you to present a poster instead.

## Poster Presentations

Posters are on display for the full length of the conference. Please attend your poster during the poster sessions. The size of each poster must not exceed A0 portrait format (84,1 cm wide x 118,9 cm high). On-site printing is not available.
