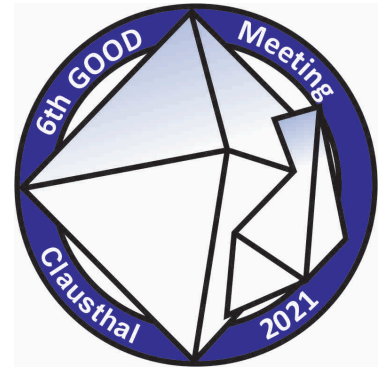


GOOD Meeting 2021

Registration & Abstracts

The conference fee is EUR 40 payable by bank transfer (cash payments is possible onsite). Included in the fee is a printed copy of the abstract volume, a lunch option and cold and hot drinks. Students who are members of the DMG and not based in Clausthal may be eligible for a EUR 50 travel grant. The registration form and the abstract template can be found in the attachments. Posters are on display for the full length of the conference. Please attend your poster during the poster sessions. The size of each poster must not exceed A0 portrait format (84.1 cm wide x 118.9 cm high).
